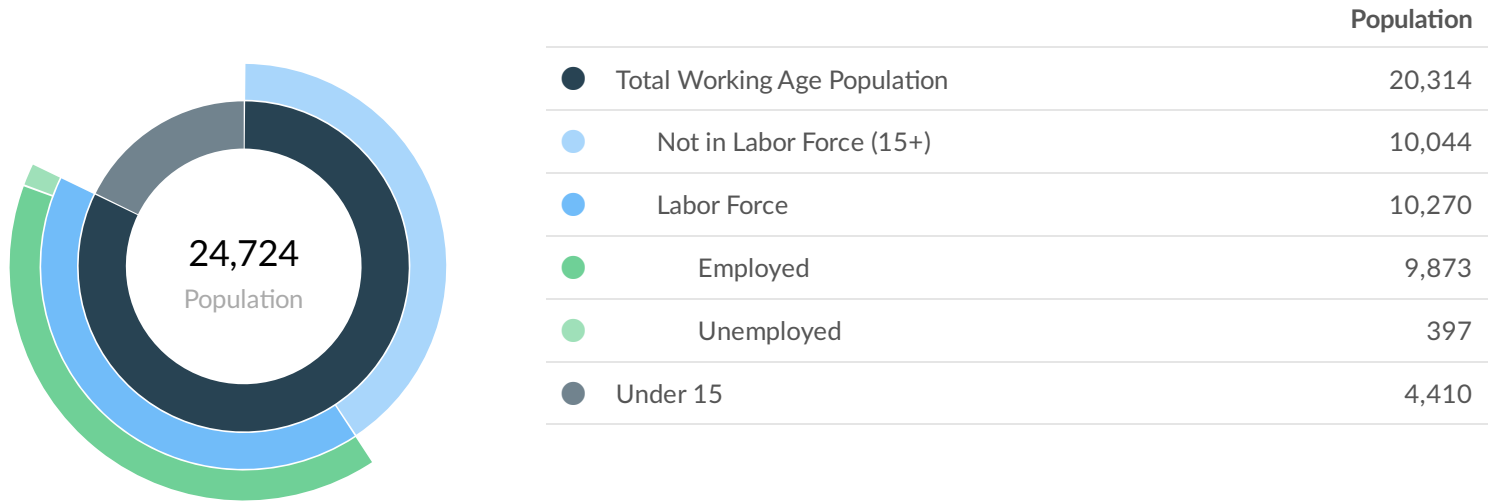
Median household income is **\$13.7K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 1.3%** since 2015, falling by 317. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.6%** between 2020 and 2025, losing 153.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 0.9%** in Randolph County, MO from 10,905 to **10,810**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.5%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 50.9% to 50.6% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.2% of Randolph County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% below the national average), and **13.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Warehousing and Storage, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

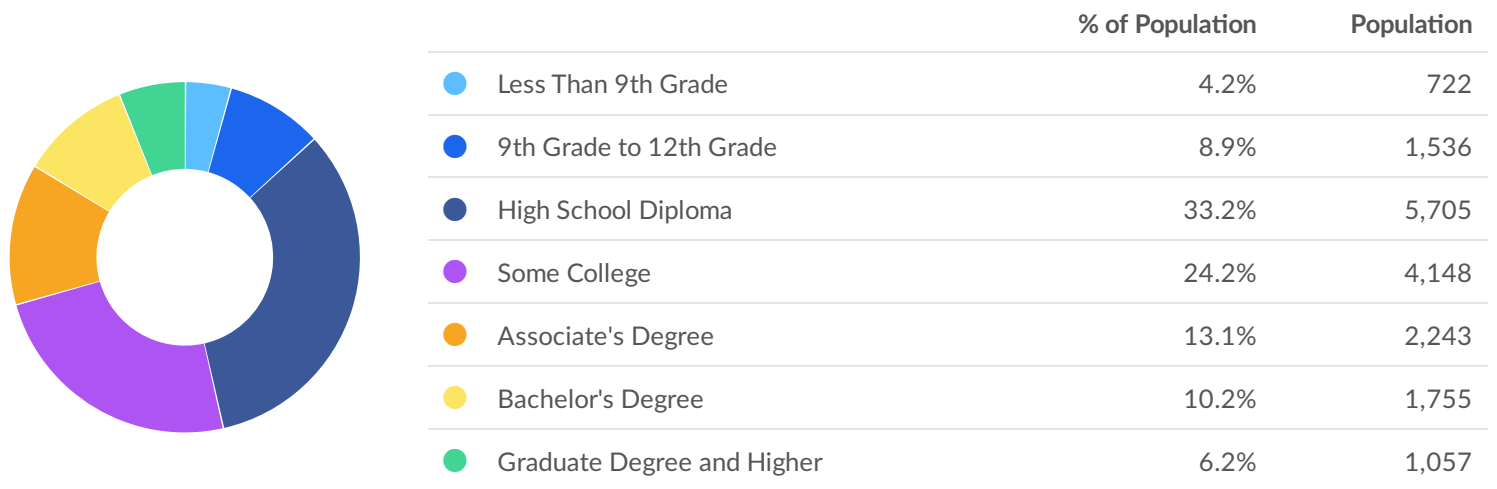

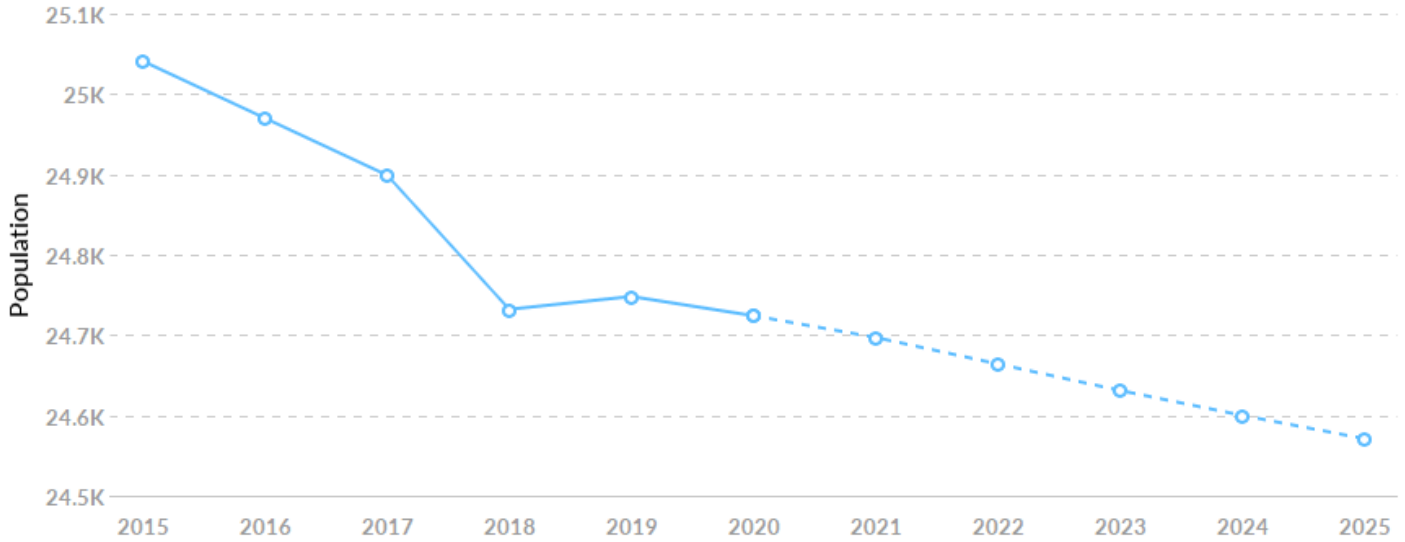

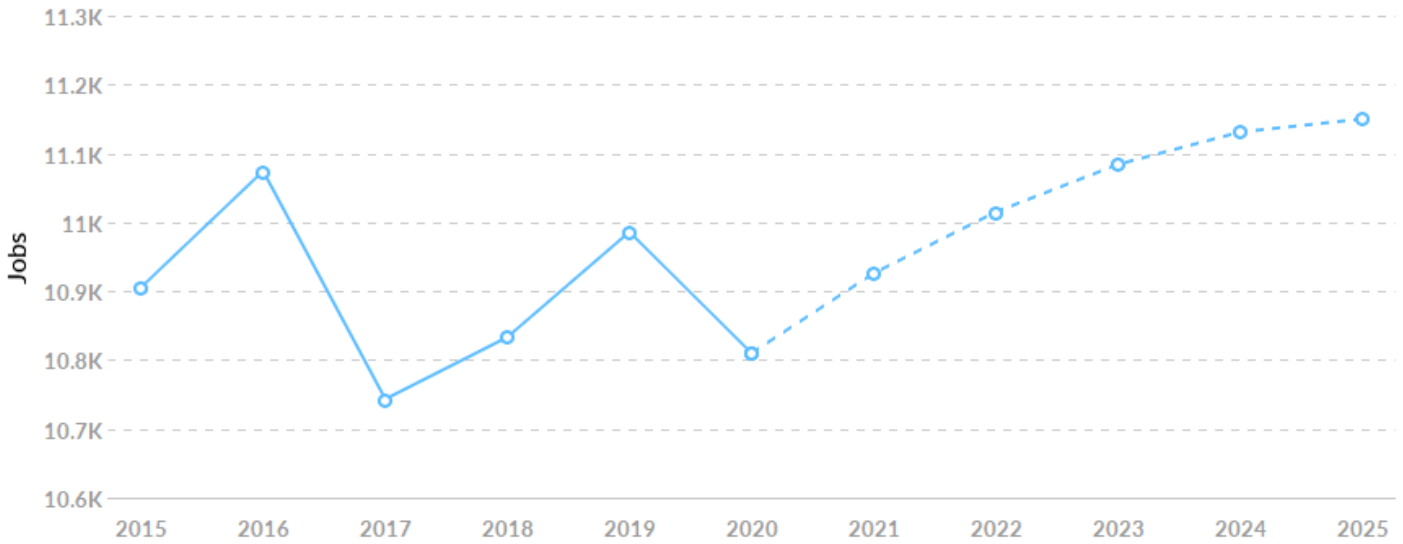

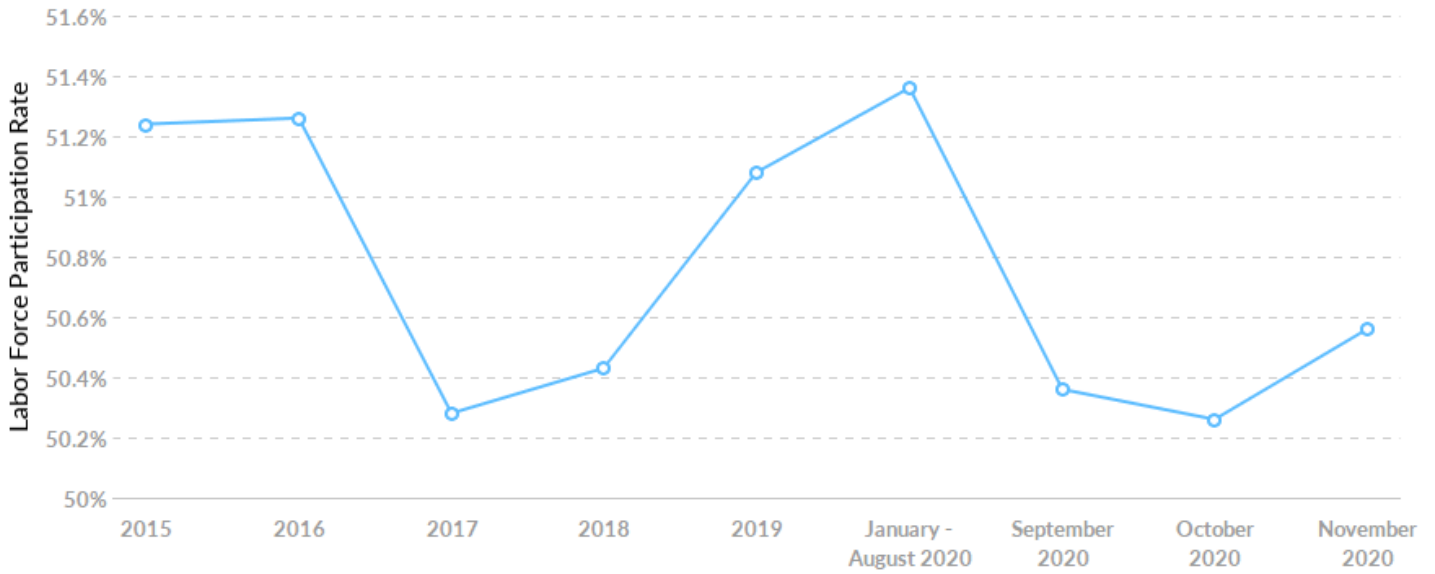
Job Trends

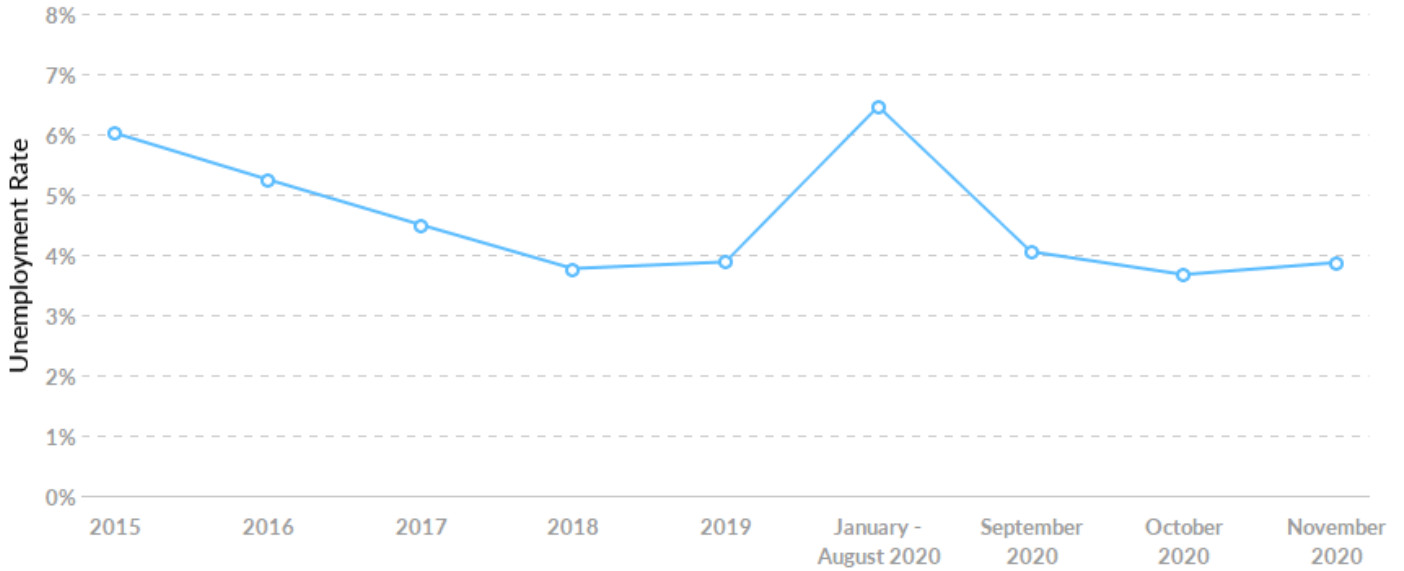

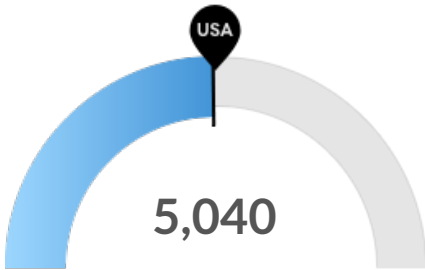
Unemployment Rate Trends

Randolph County, MO had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 3.87%, decreasing from 6.02% 5 years before.



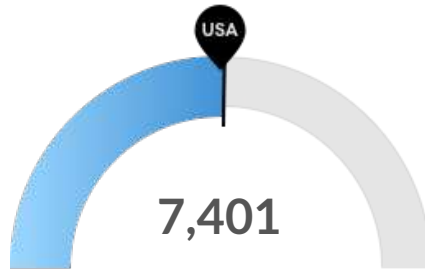

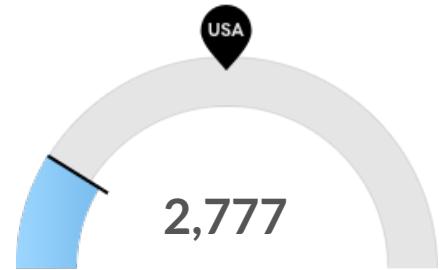
Millennials

Randolph County, MO has 5,040 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,103.



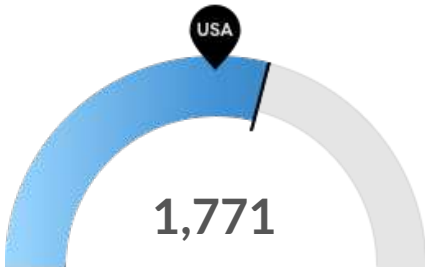
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Randolph County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 7,276 people 55 or older, while there are 7,401 here.



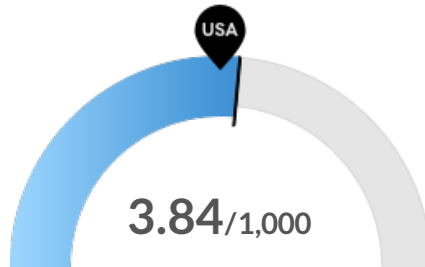
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Randolph County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 9,872 racially diverse people, while there are 2,777 here.



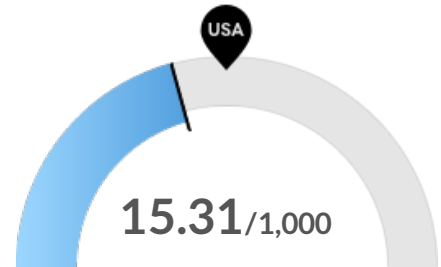
Veterans

Randolph County, MO has 3.84 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

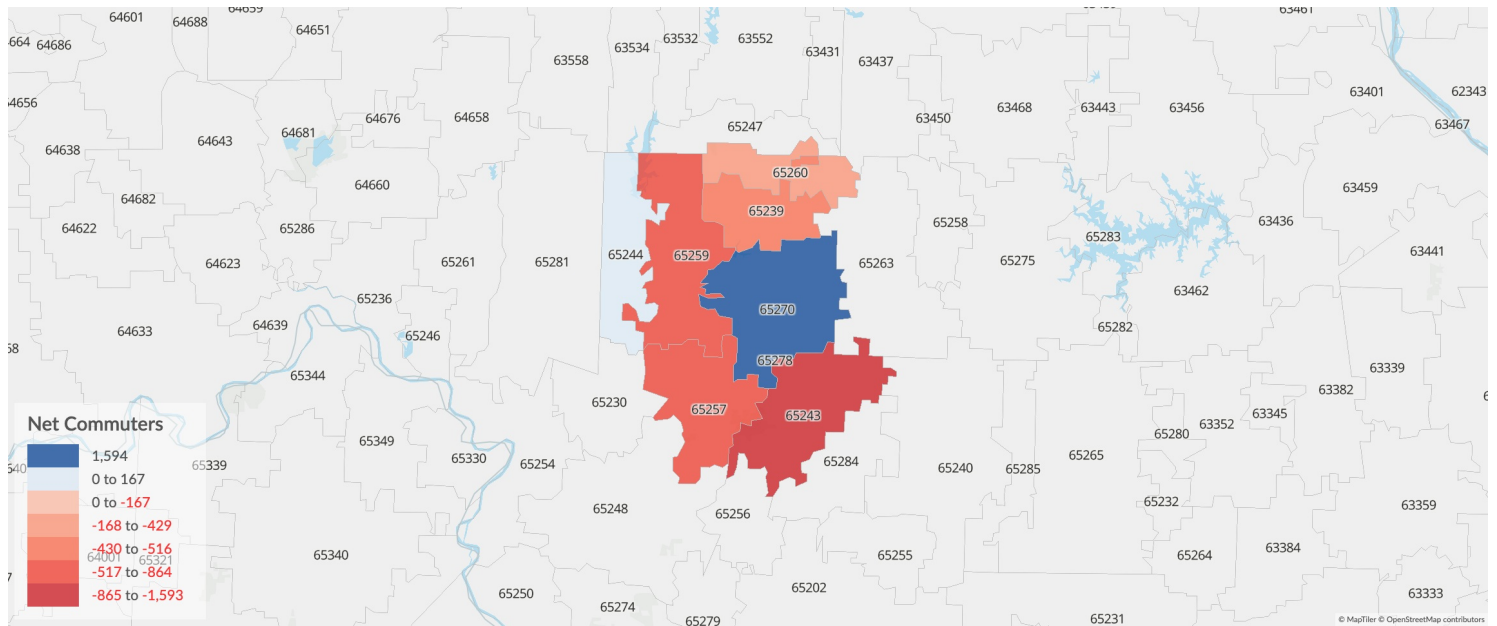


Property Crime

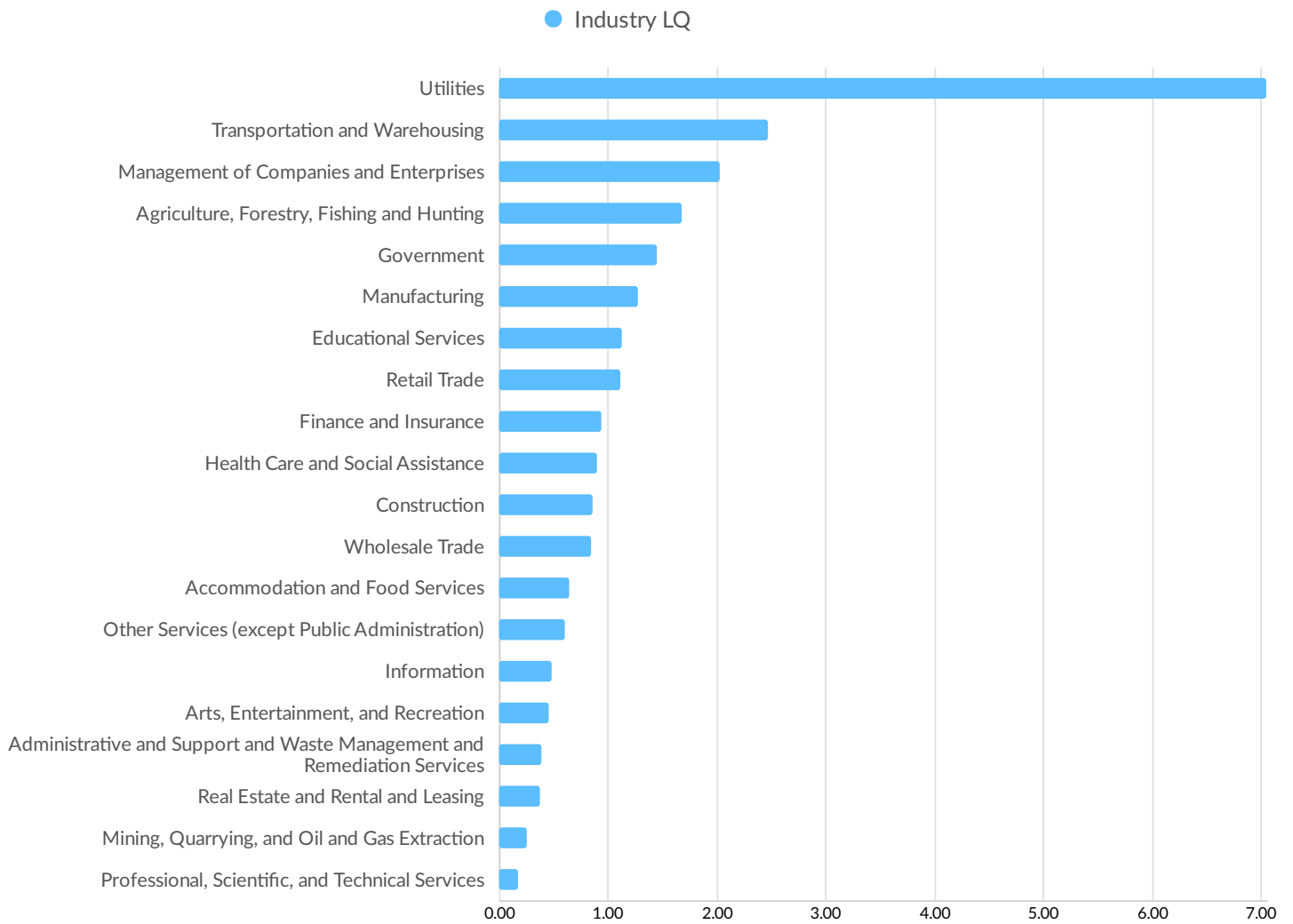

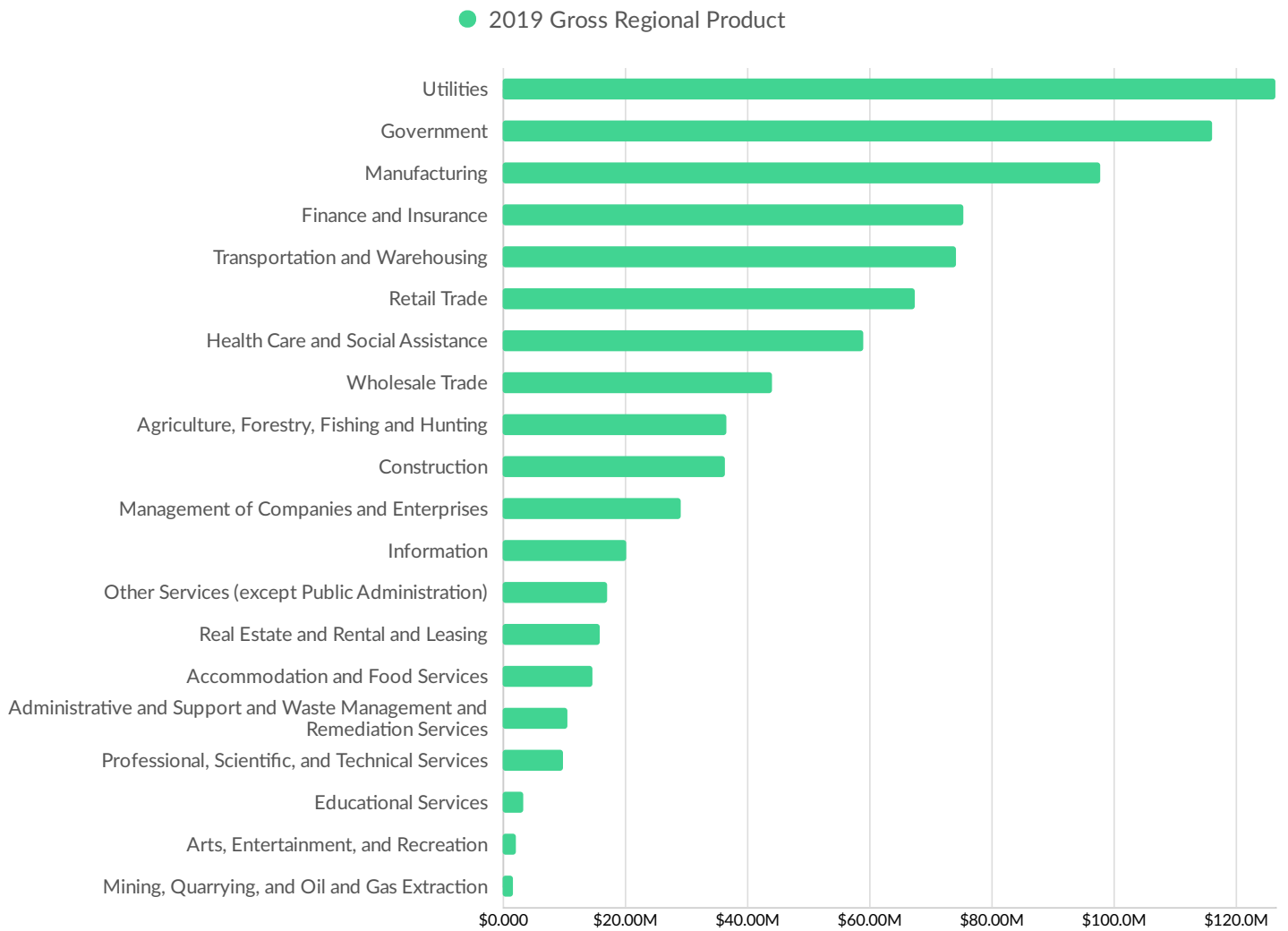

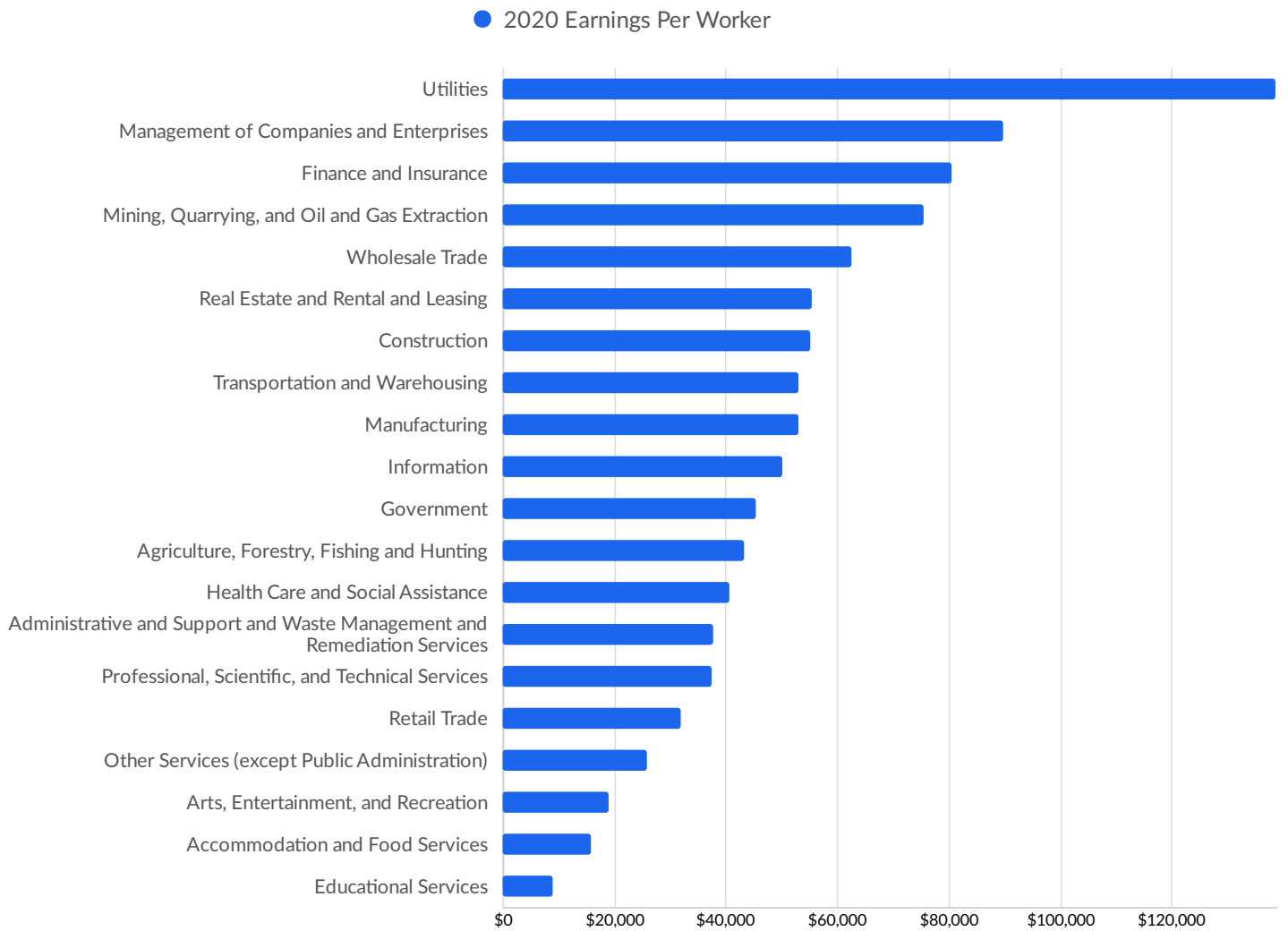
Top Industry LQ



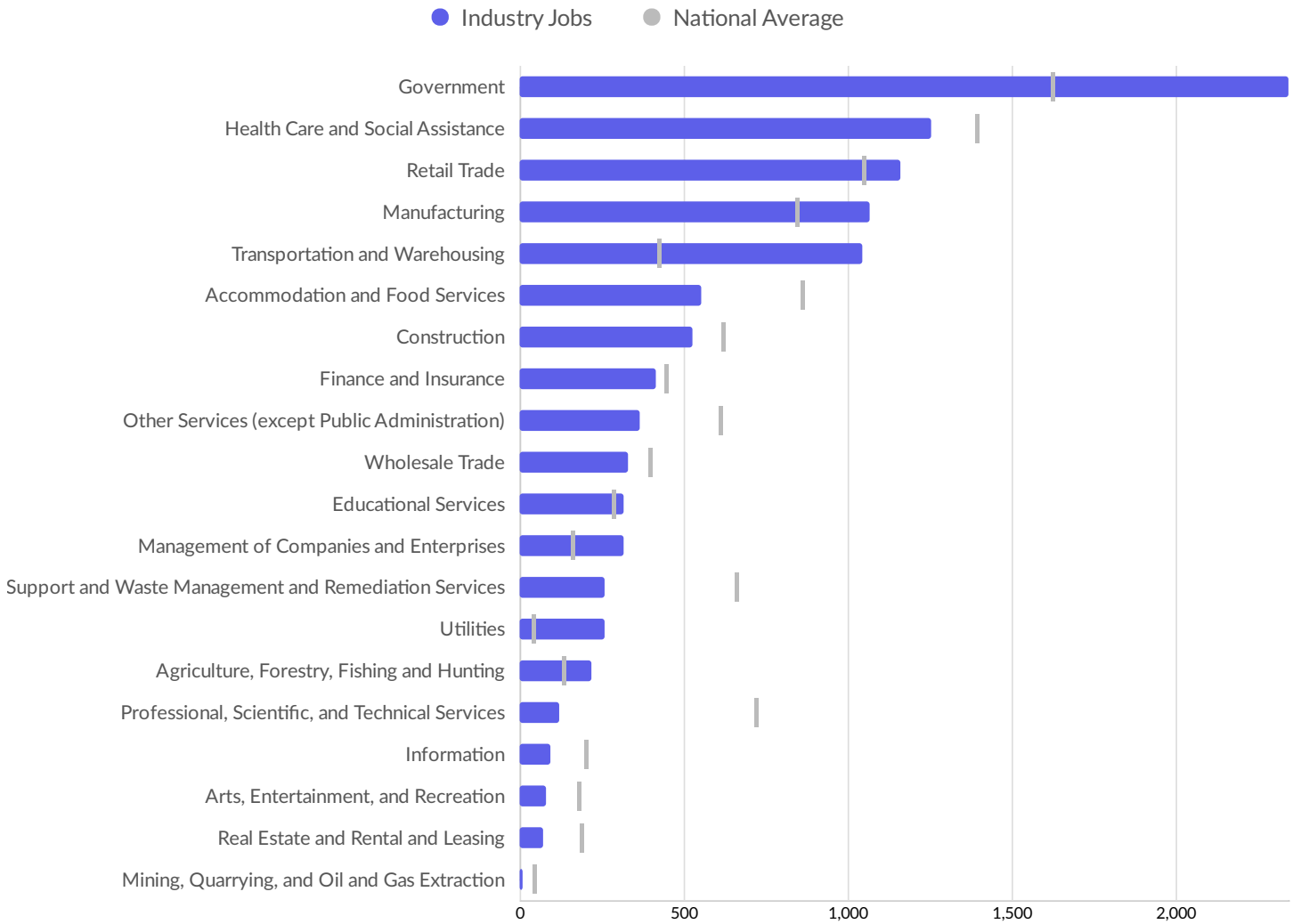

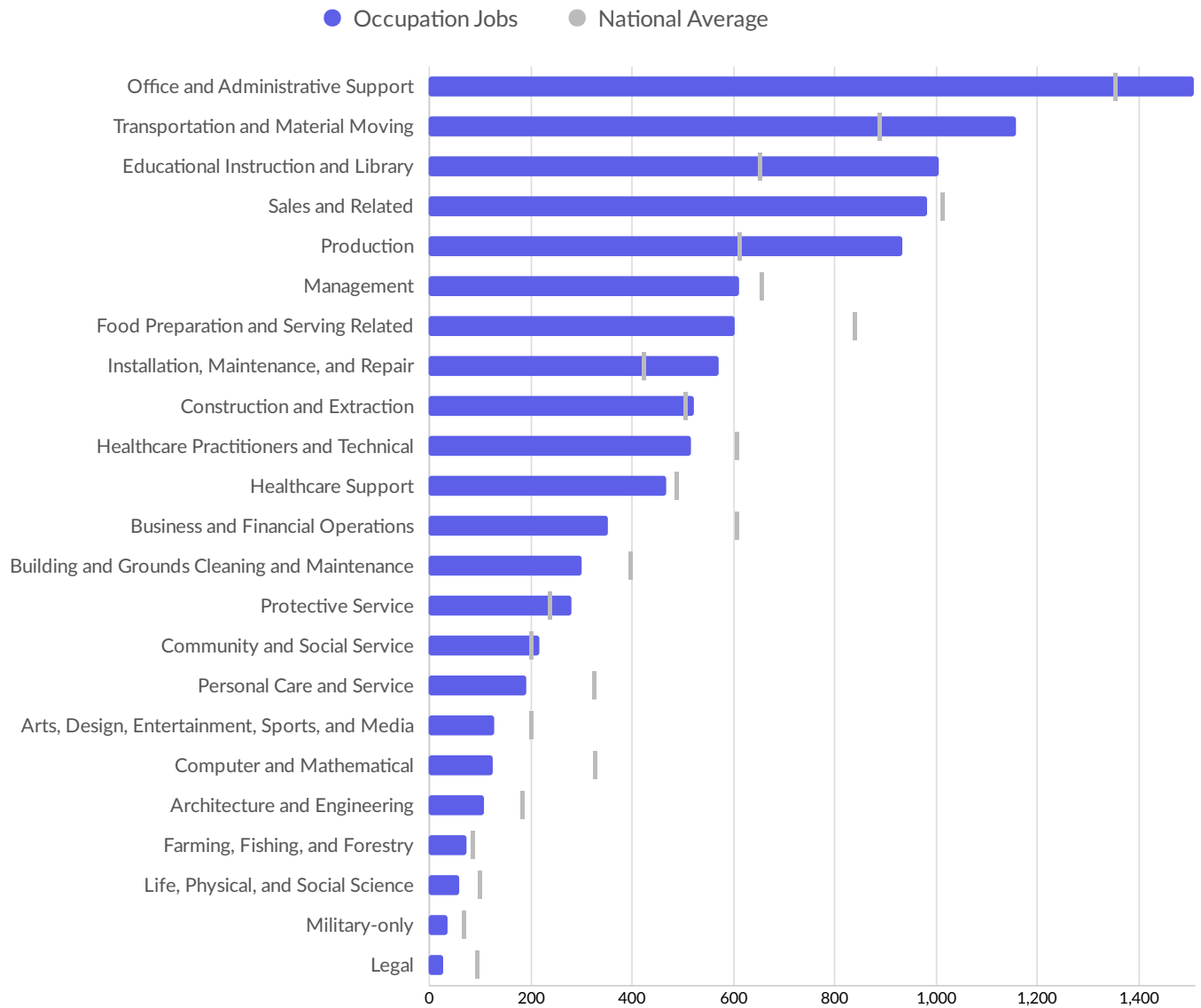

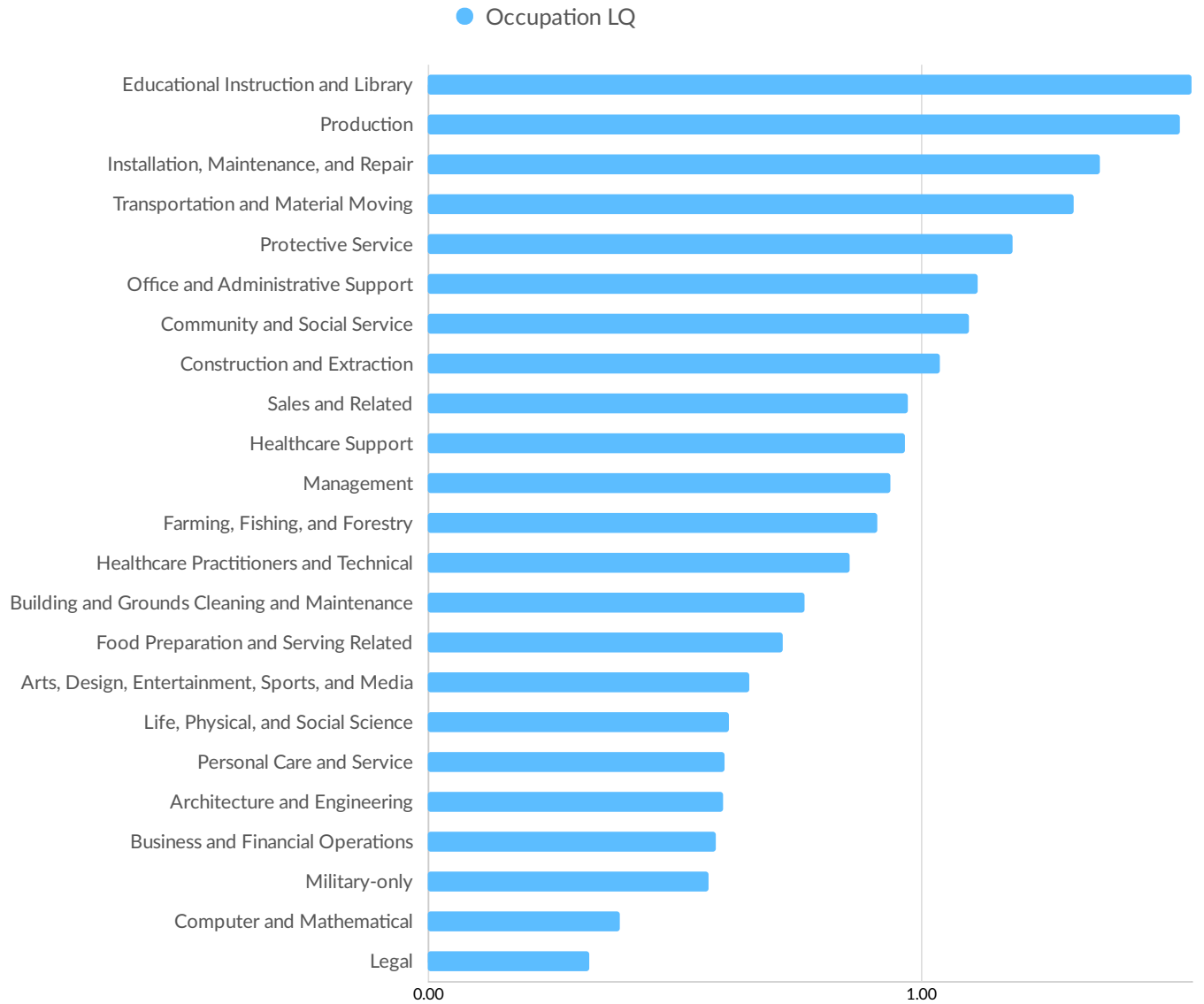

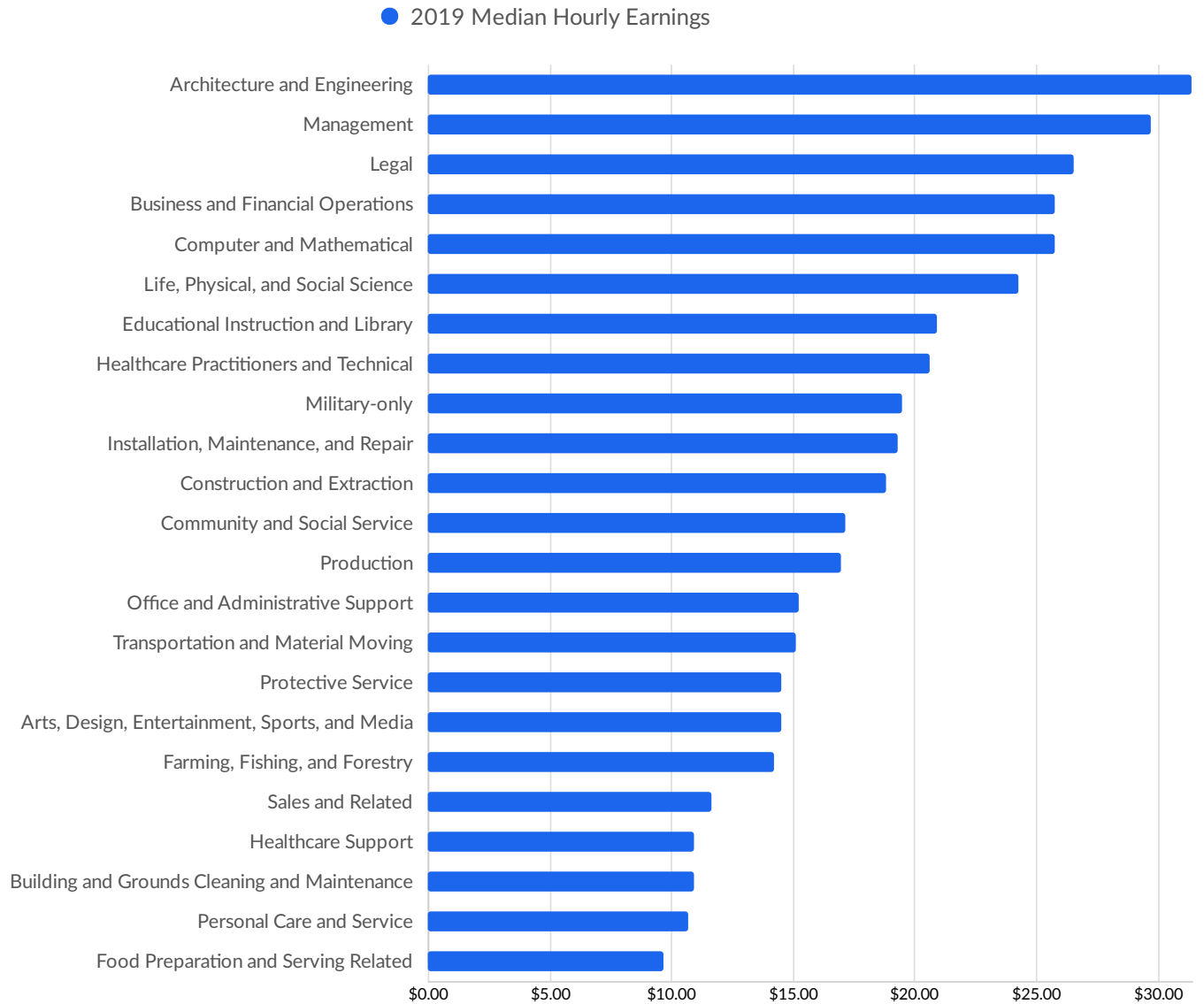
Top Growing Occupations



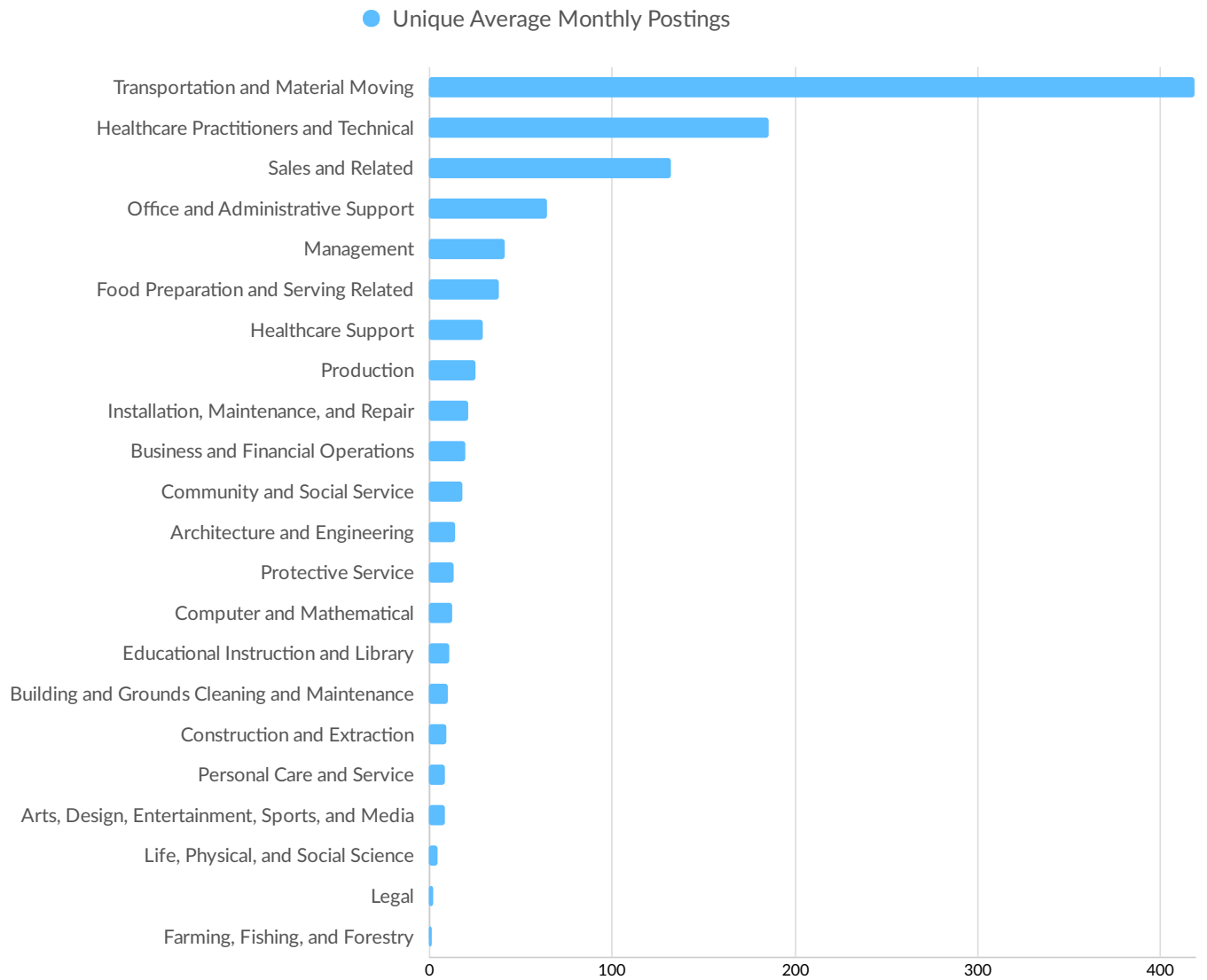

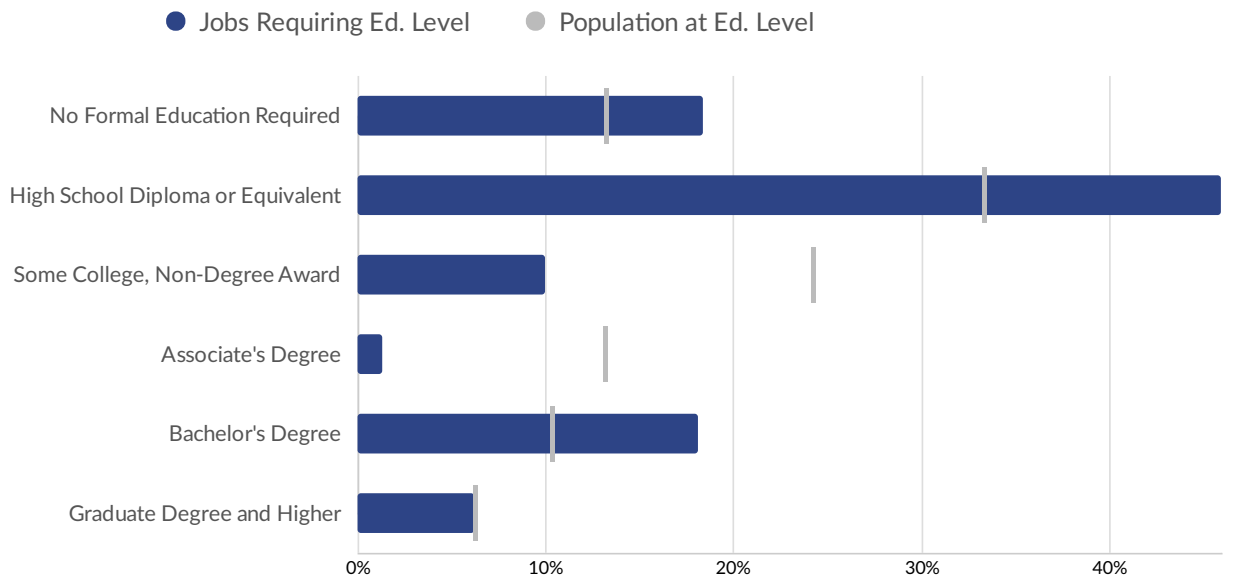


