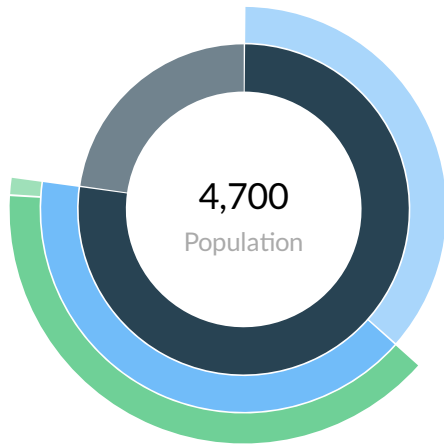
Median household income is **\$20.6K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 4.4%** since 2015, growing by 200. Population is expected to **increase by 3.7%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 172.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 7.3%** in Schuyler County, MO from 922 to **855**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 10.9%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 54.0% to 52.7% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.3% of Schuyler County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (13.7% below the national average), and **5.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Gasoline Stations.

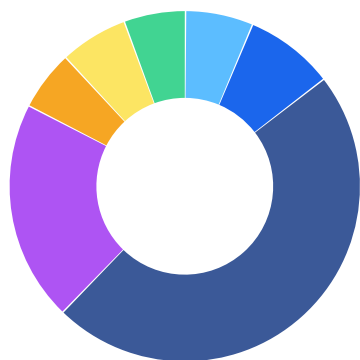

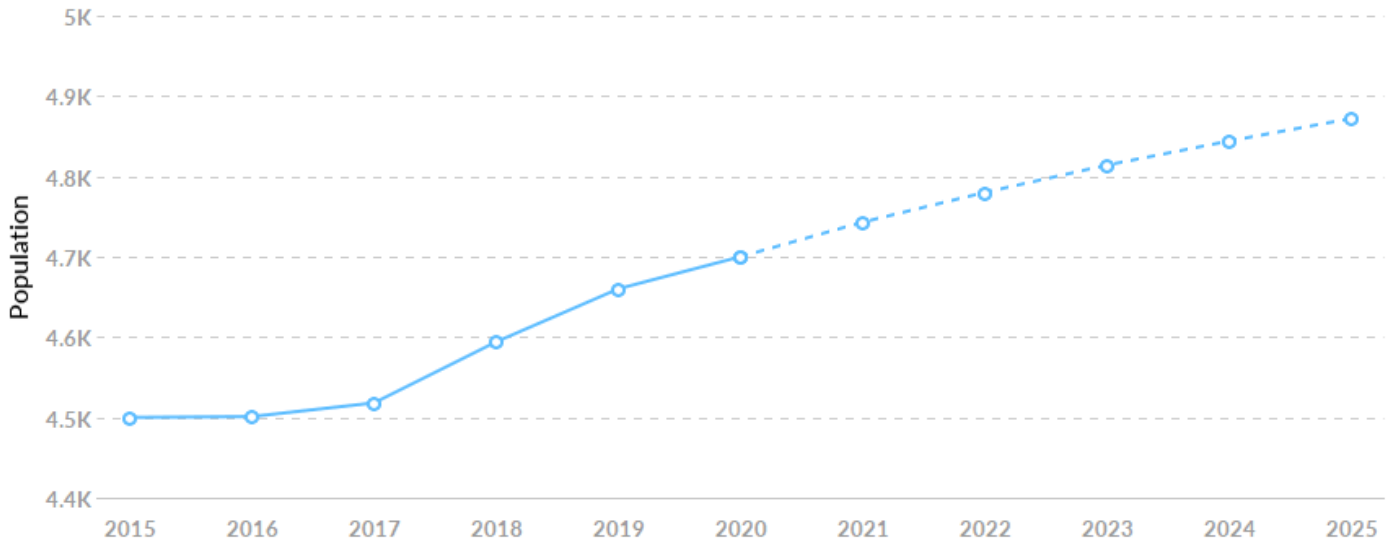

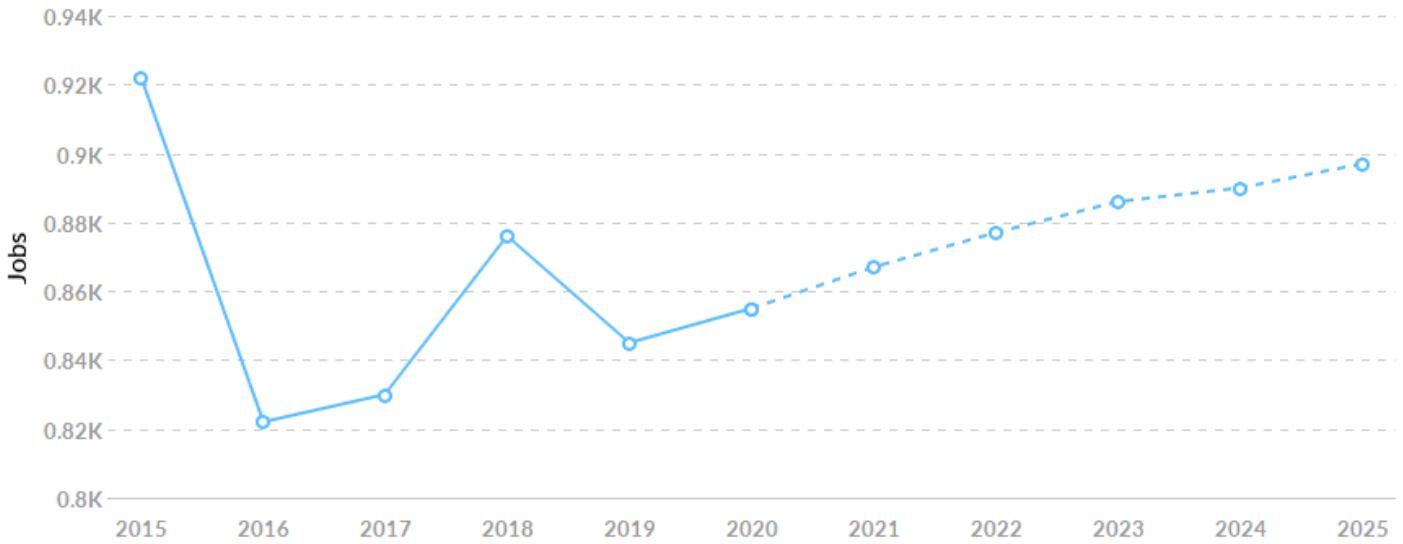

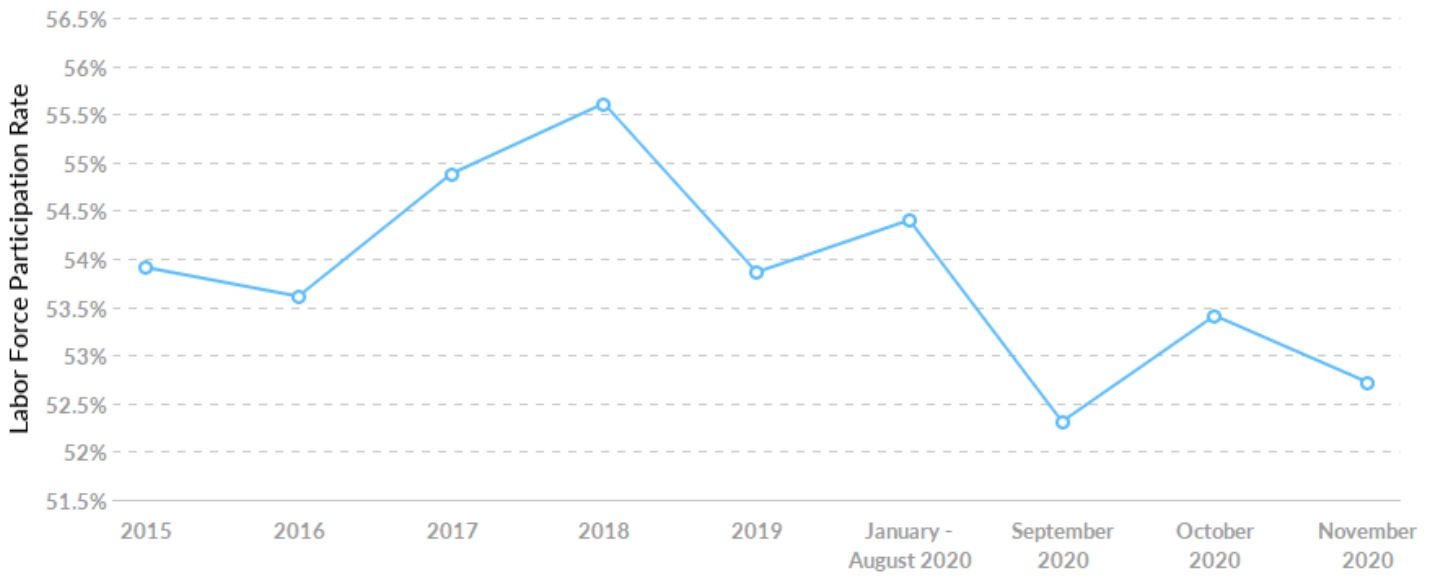
Job Trends

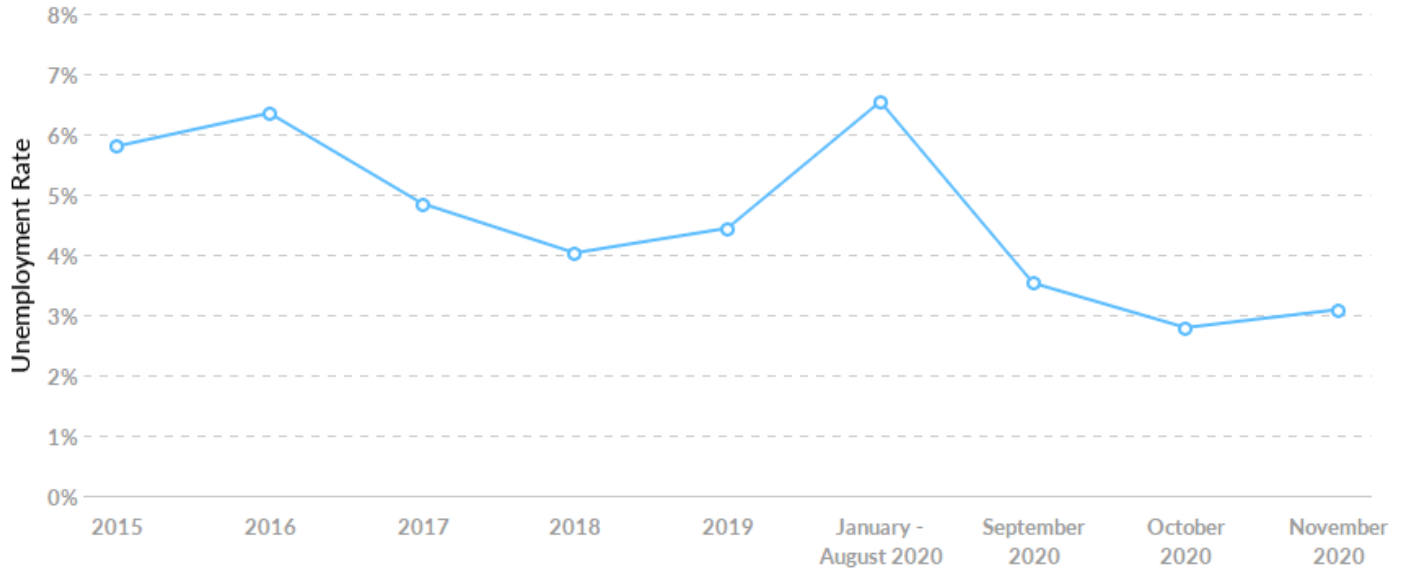

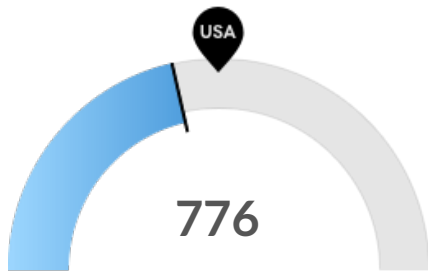
Unemployment Rate Trends

Schuyler County, MO had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 3.09%, **decreasing from 5.80%** 5 years before.



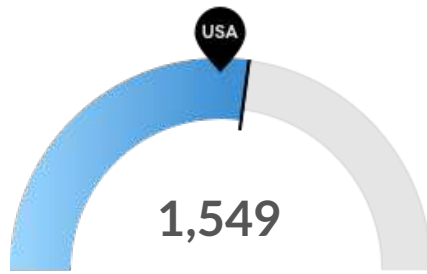

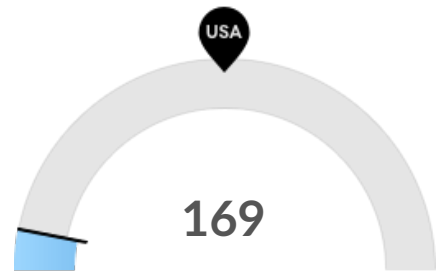
Millennials

Schuyler County, MO has 776 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 961.



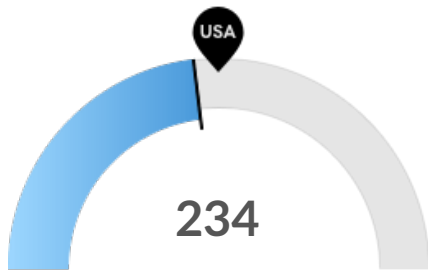
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Schuyler County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 1,370 people 55 or older, while there are 1,549 here.



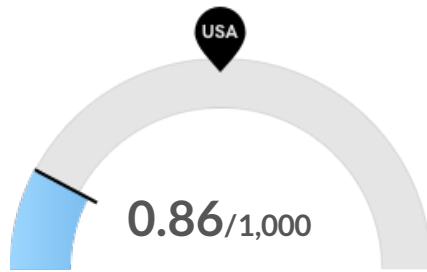
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Schuyler County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 1,859 racially diverse people, while there are 169 here.



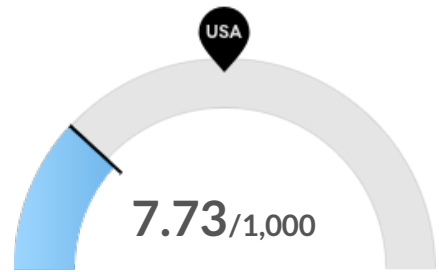
Veterans

Schuyler County, MO has 0.86 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

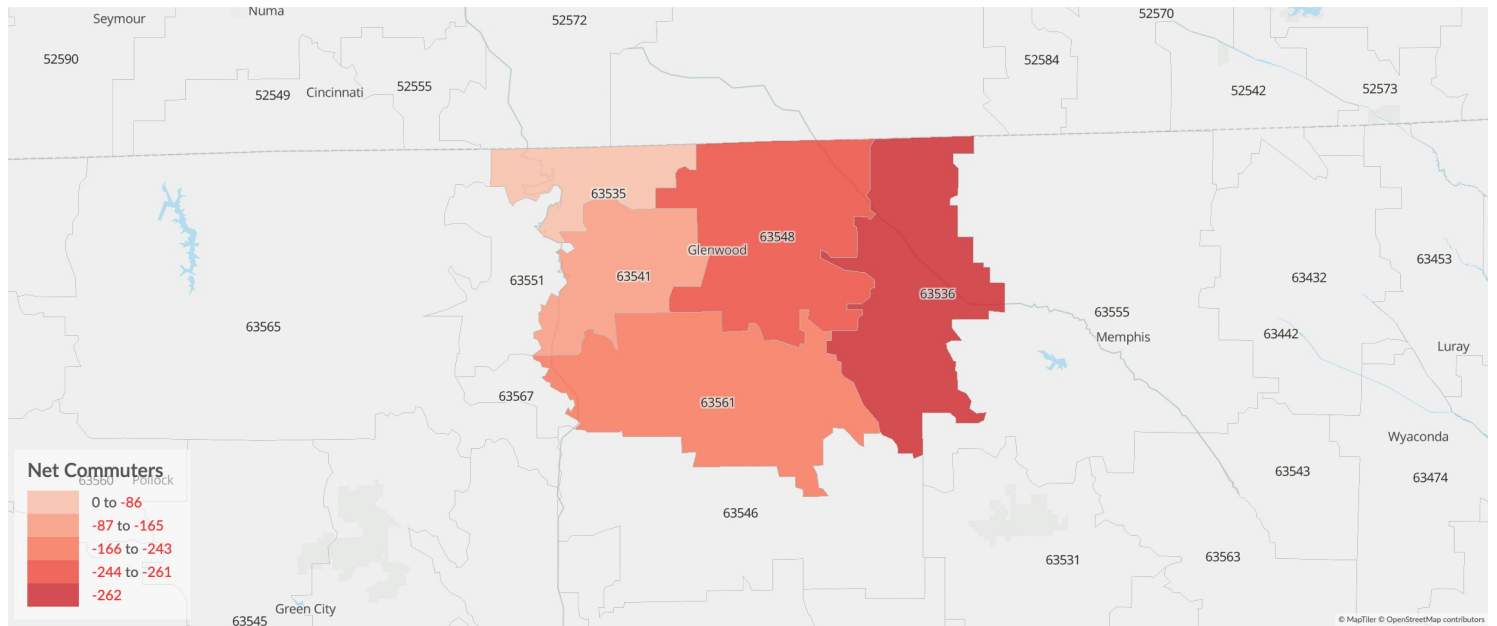


Property Crime

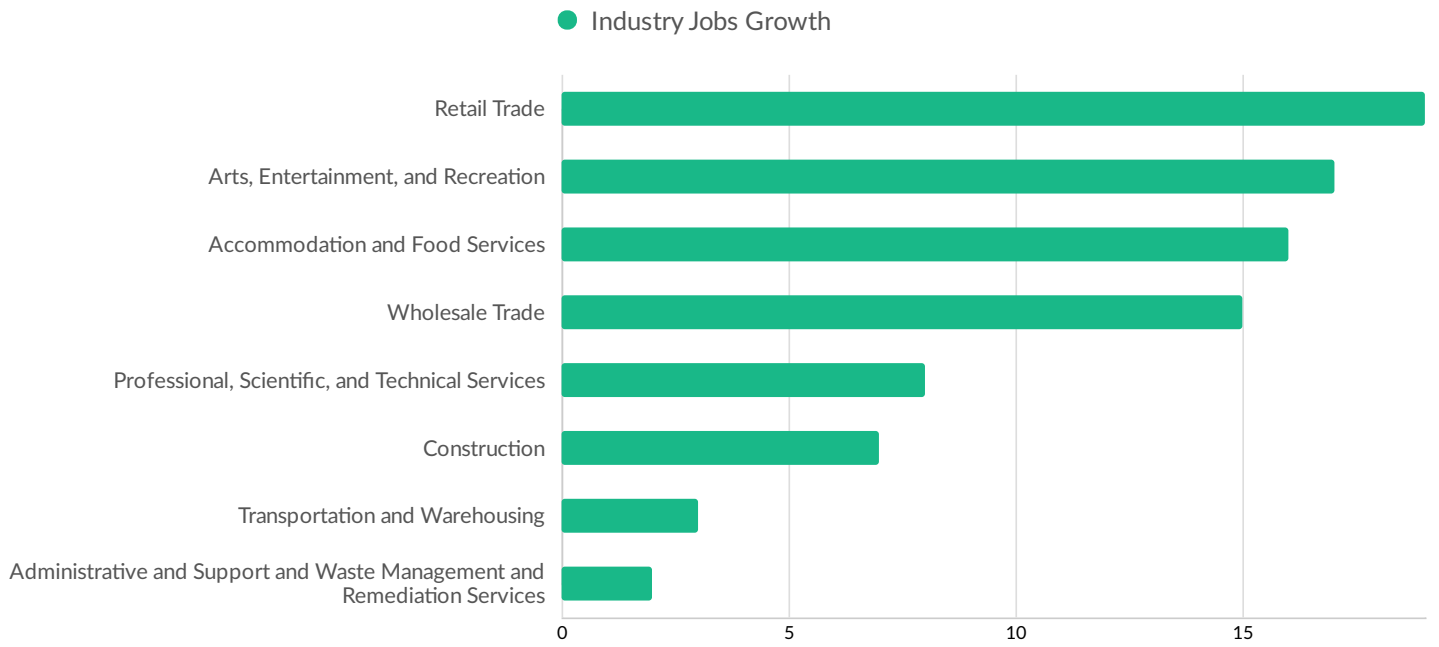

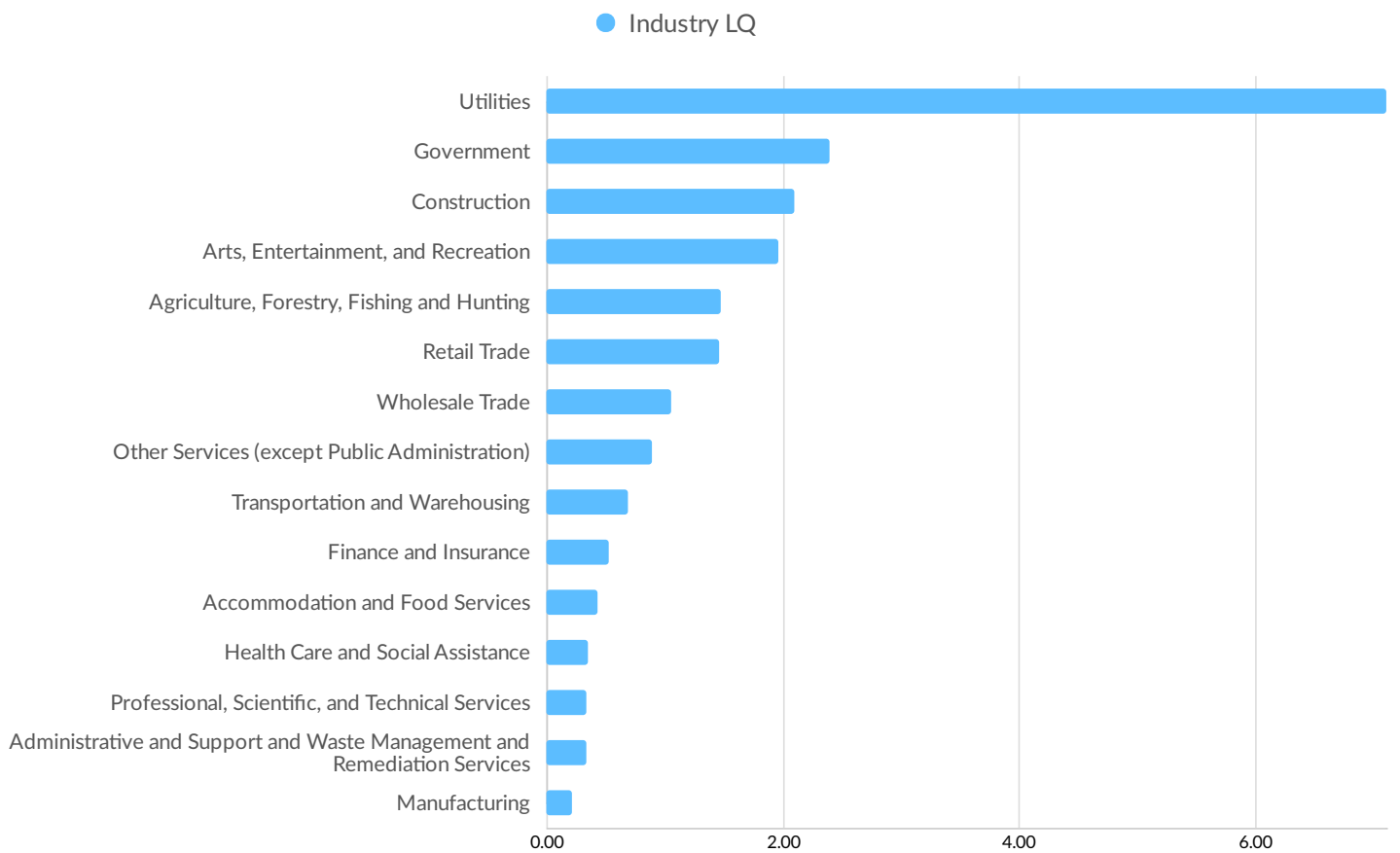

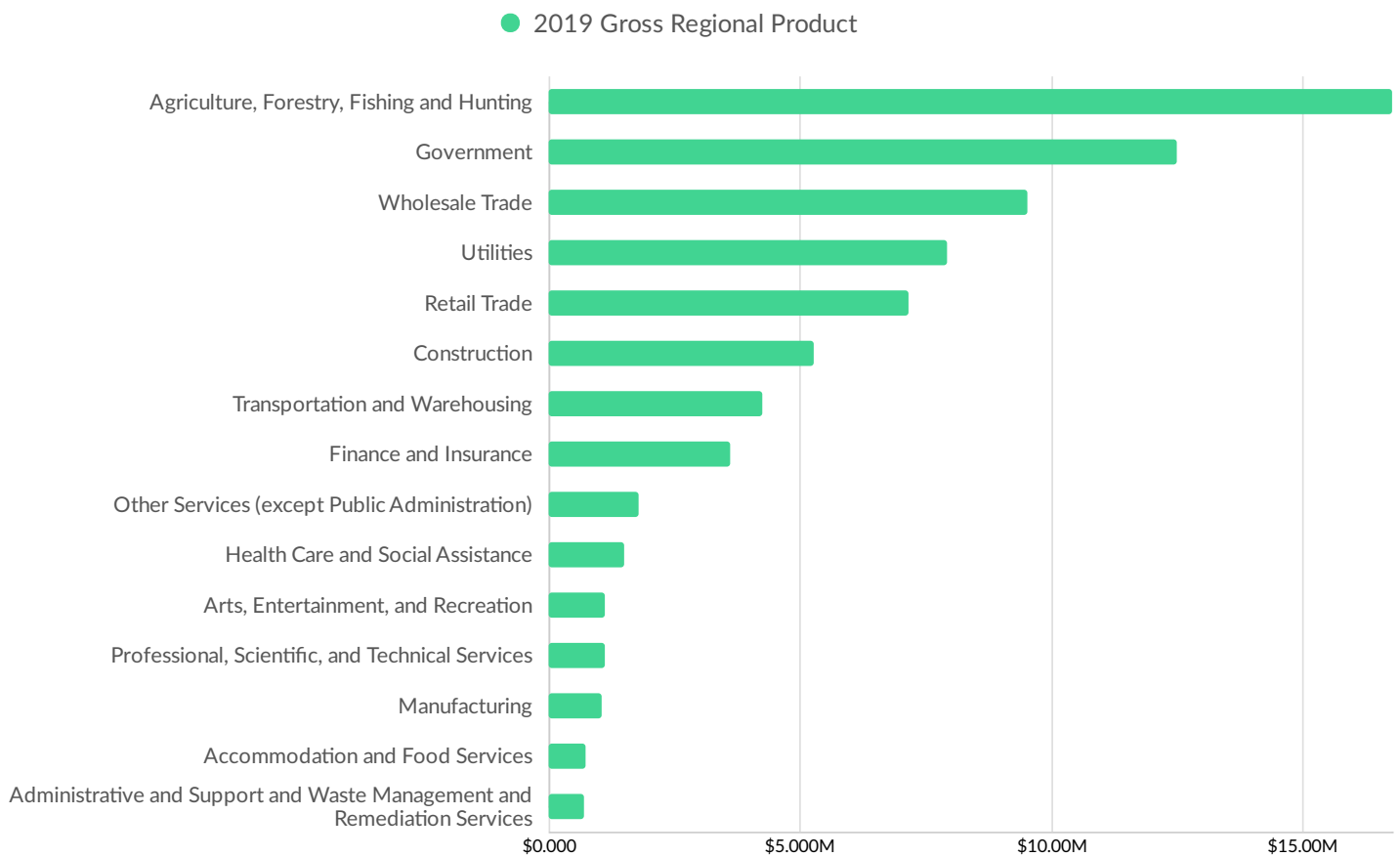
Top Growing Industries



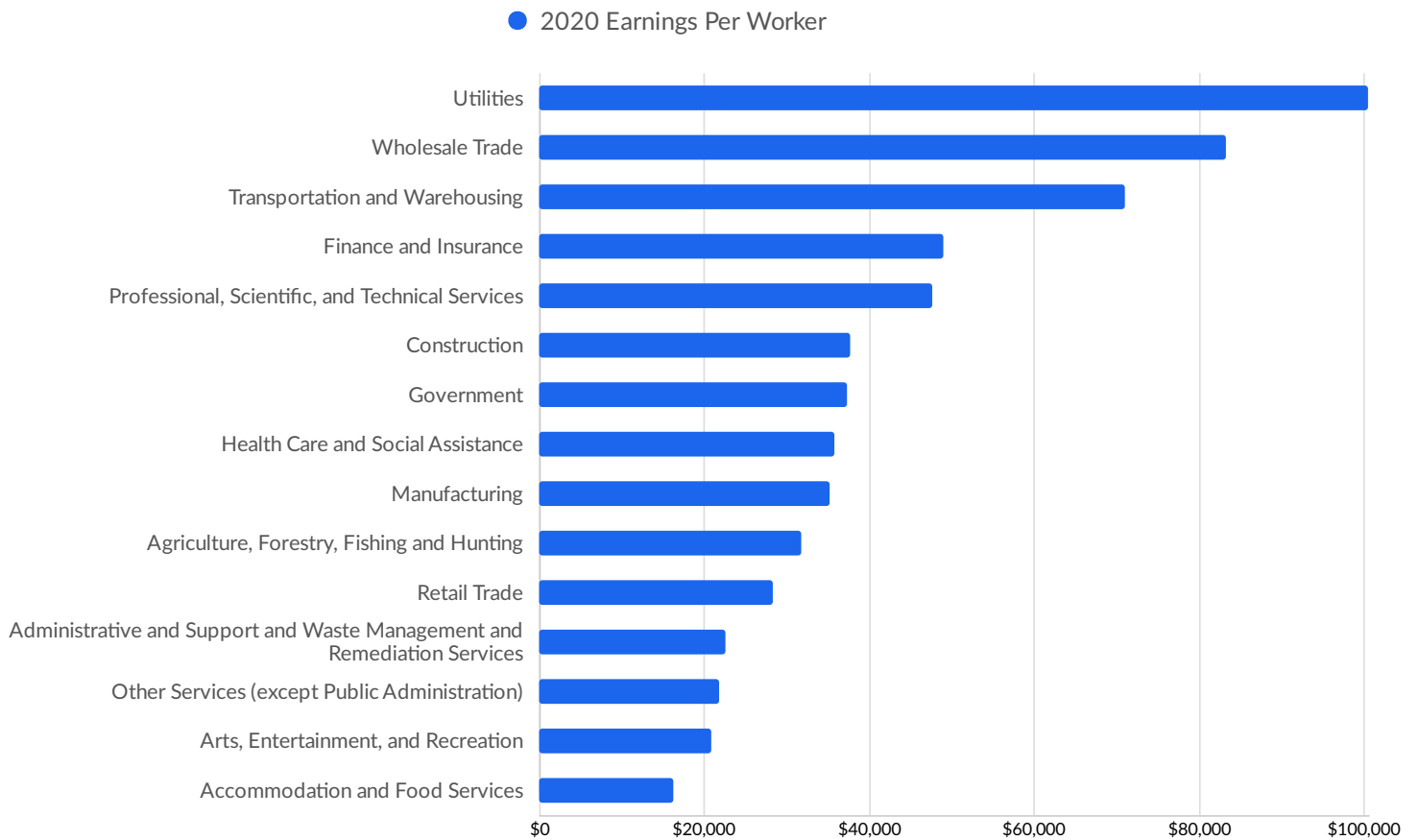
Top Industry LQ



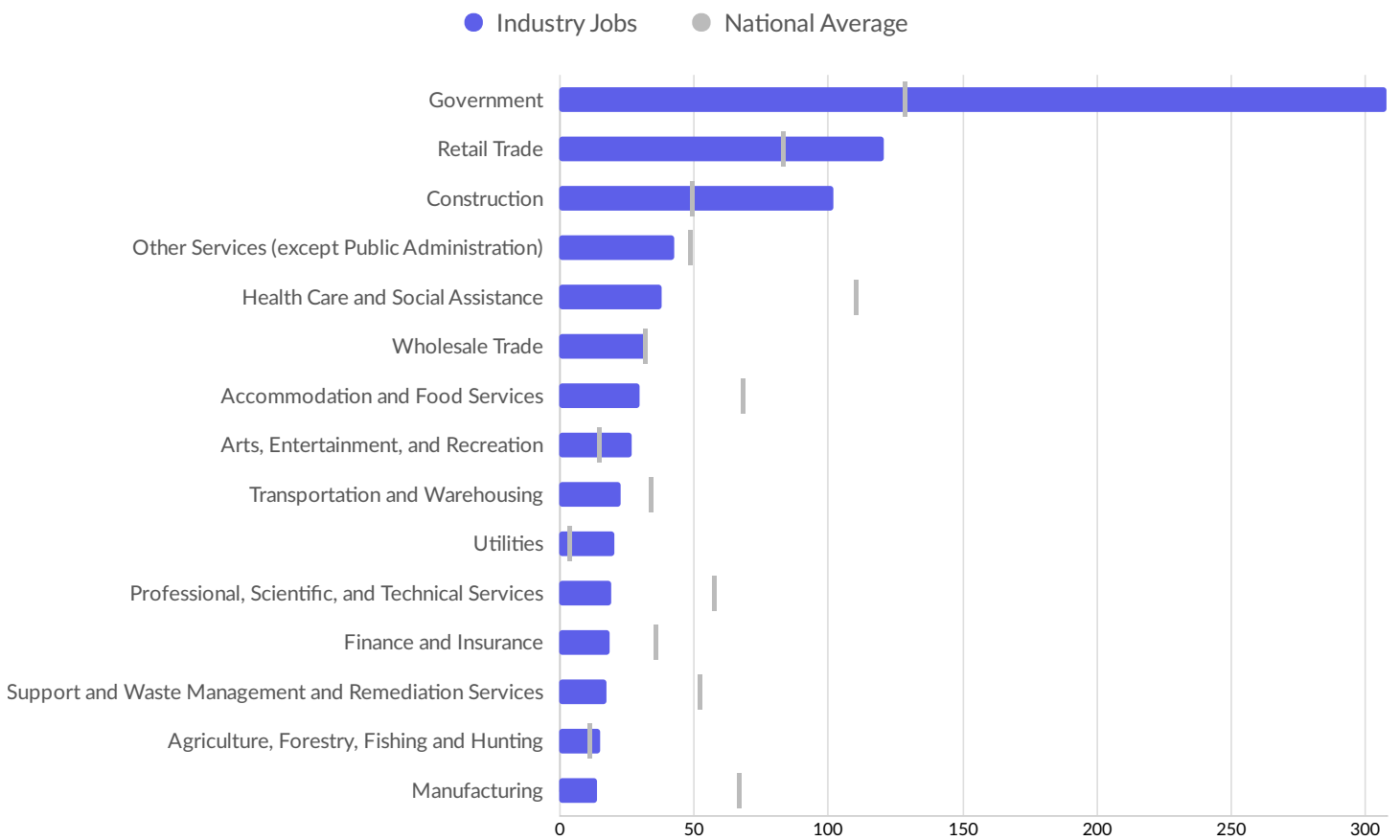

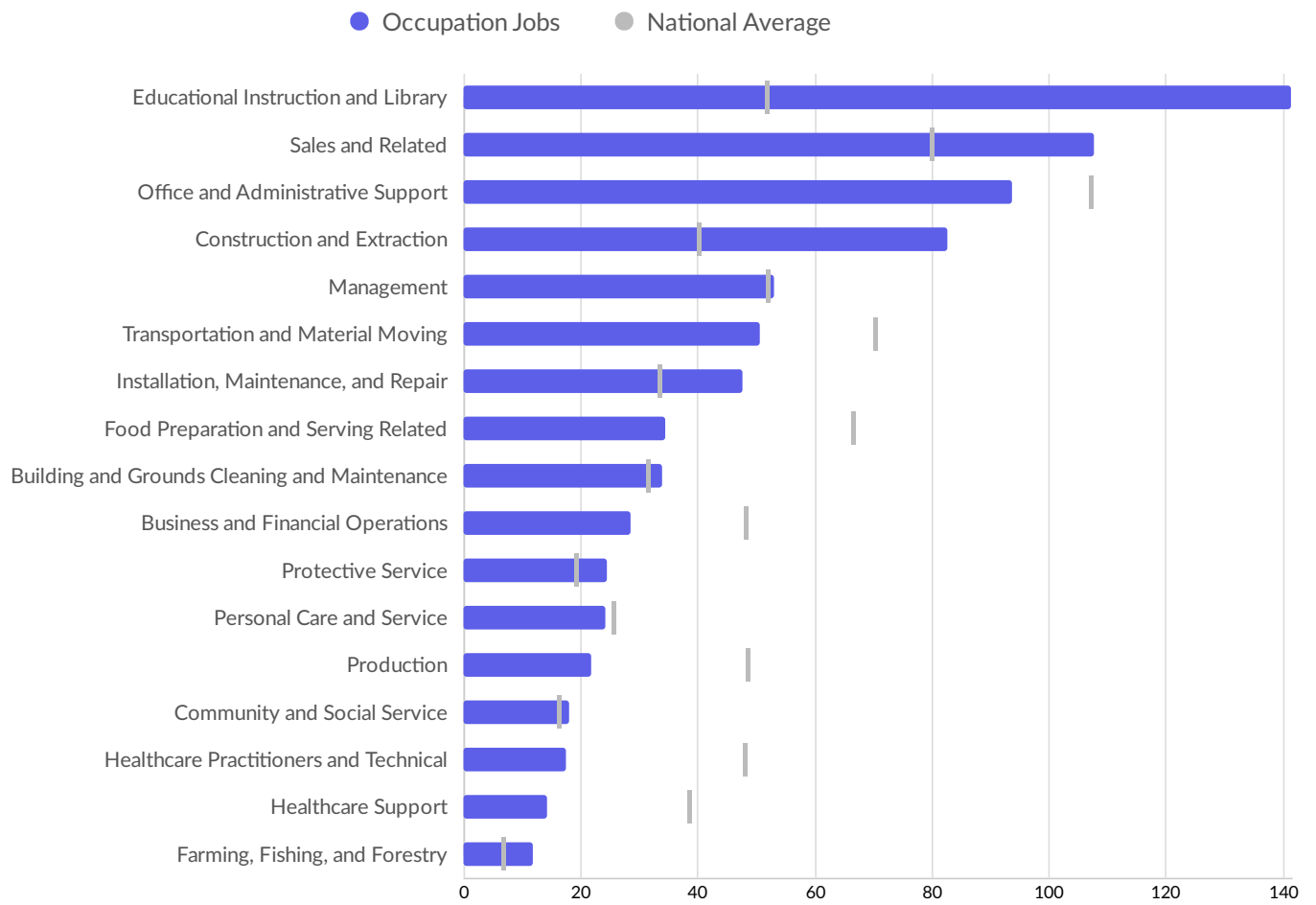

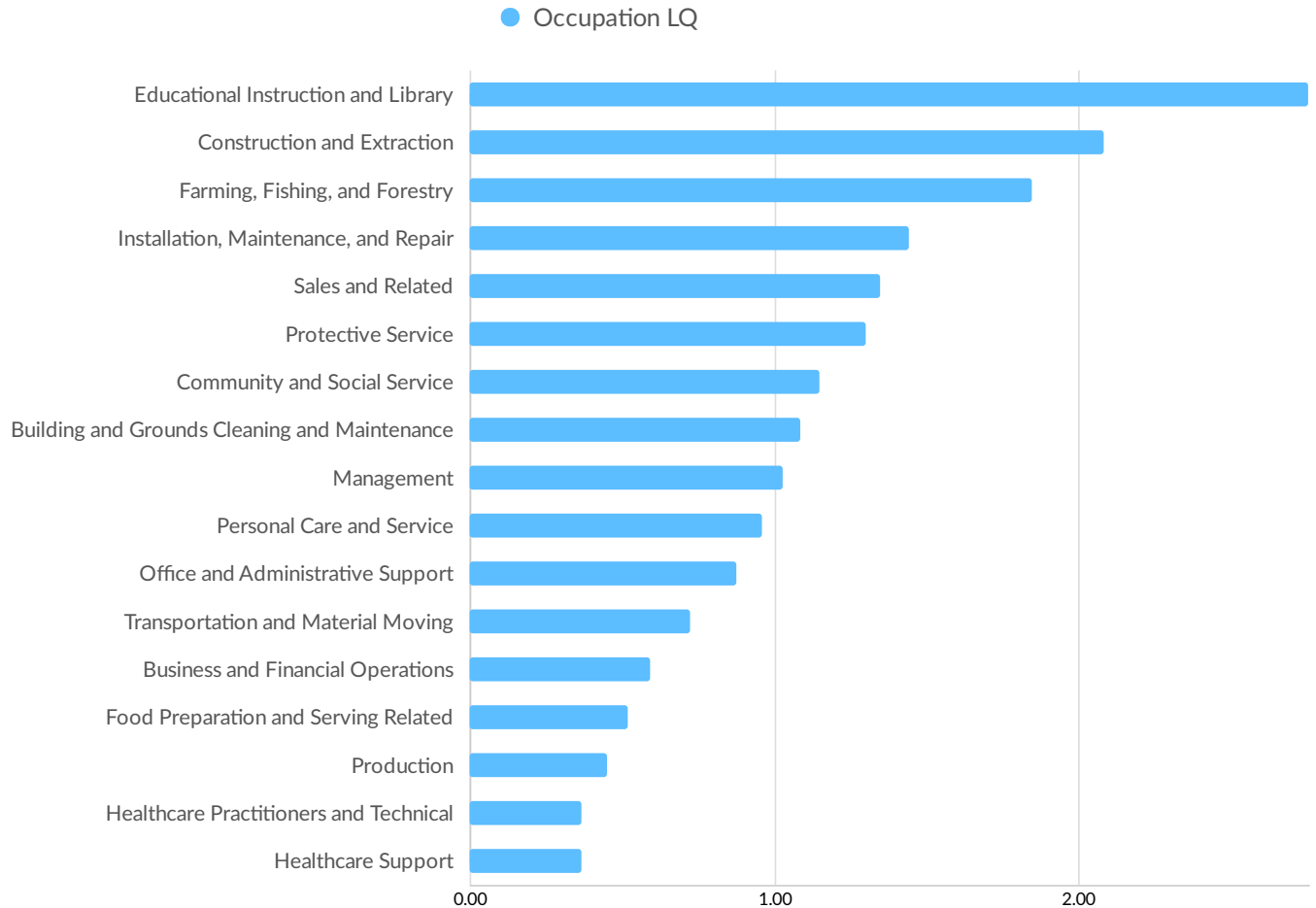

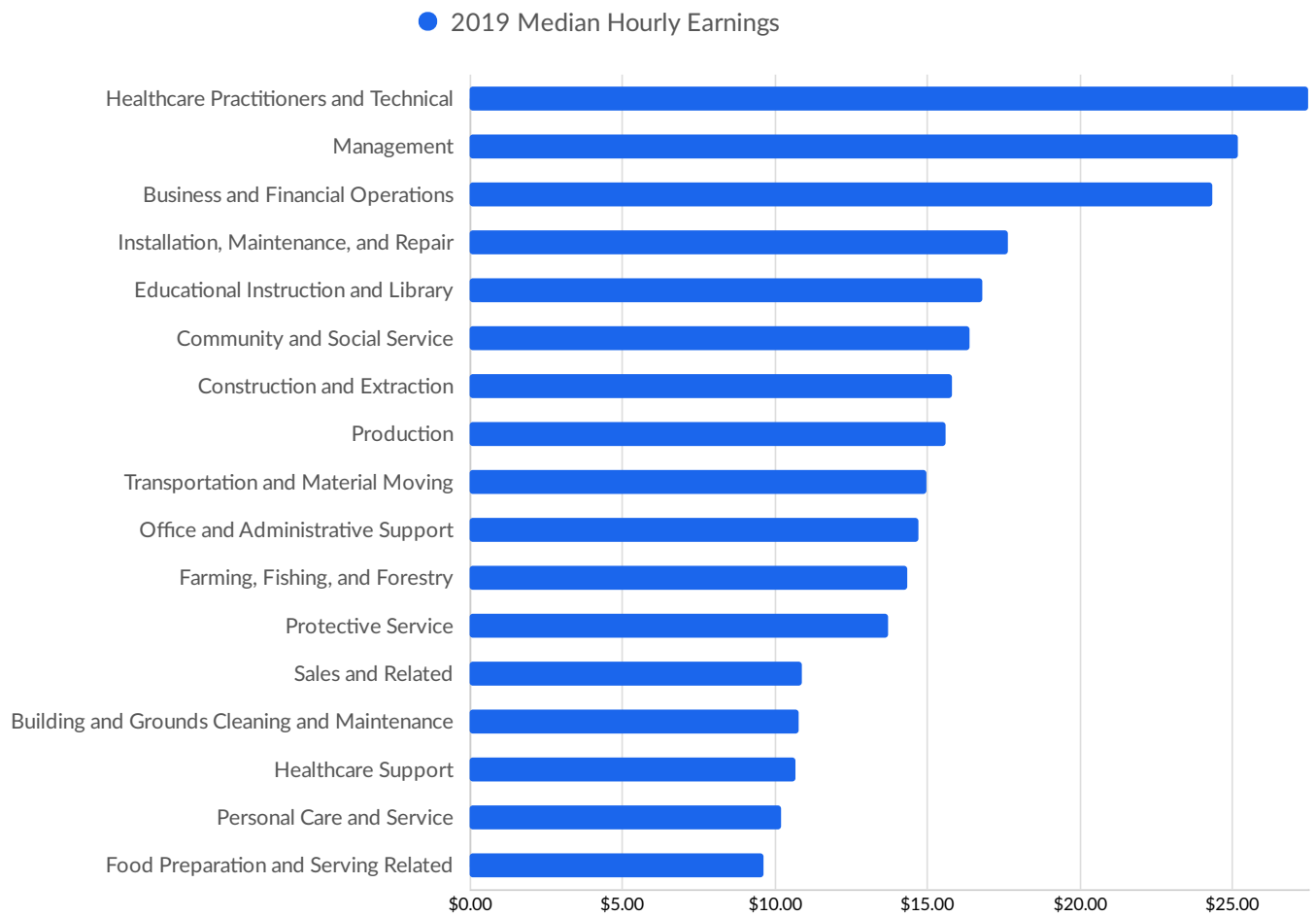
Top Growing Occupations



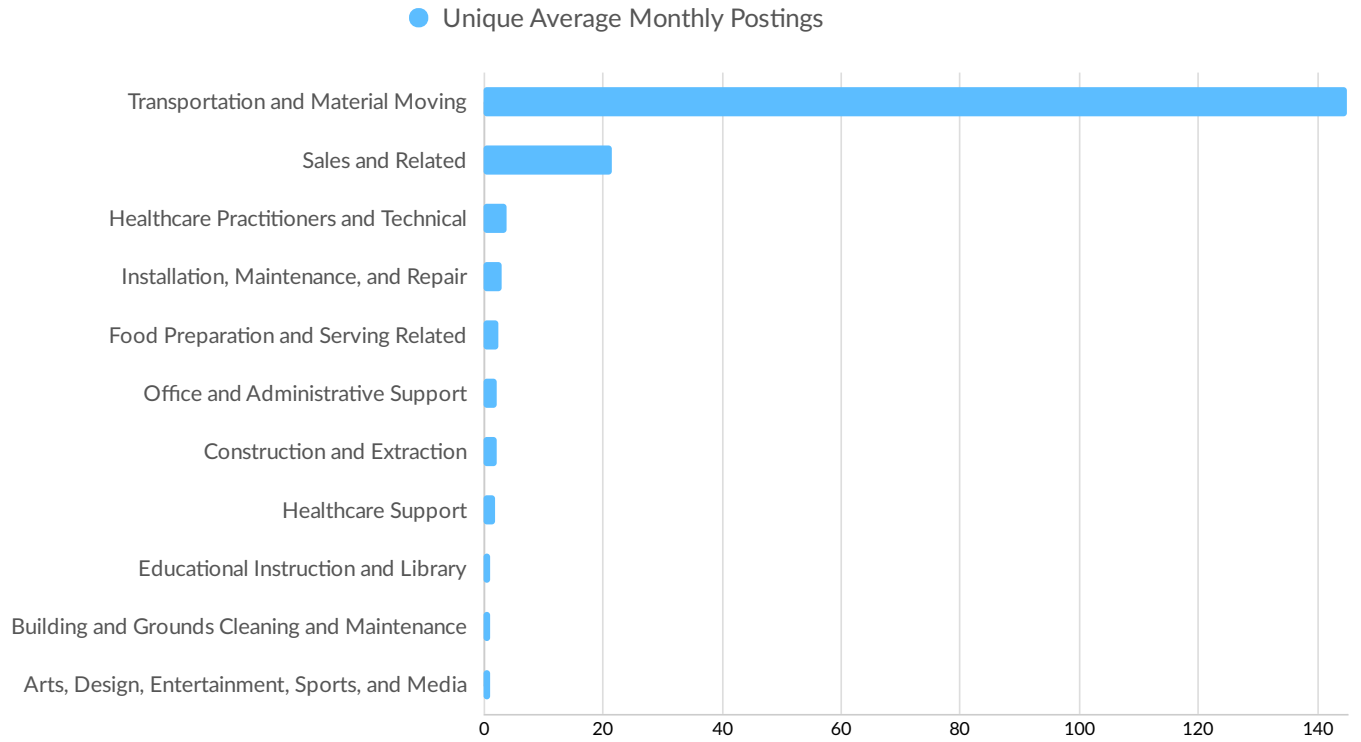
Top Occupation LQ



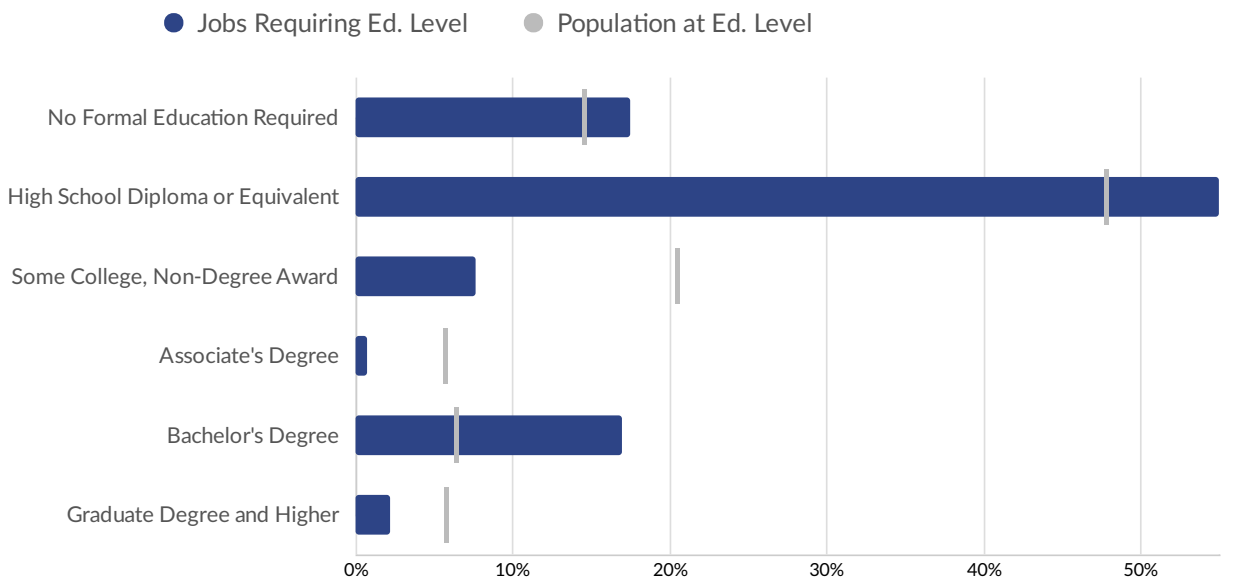
Top Occupation Earnings



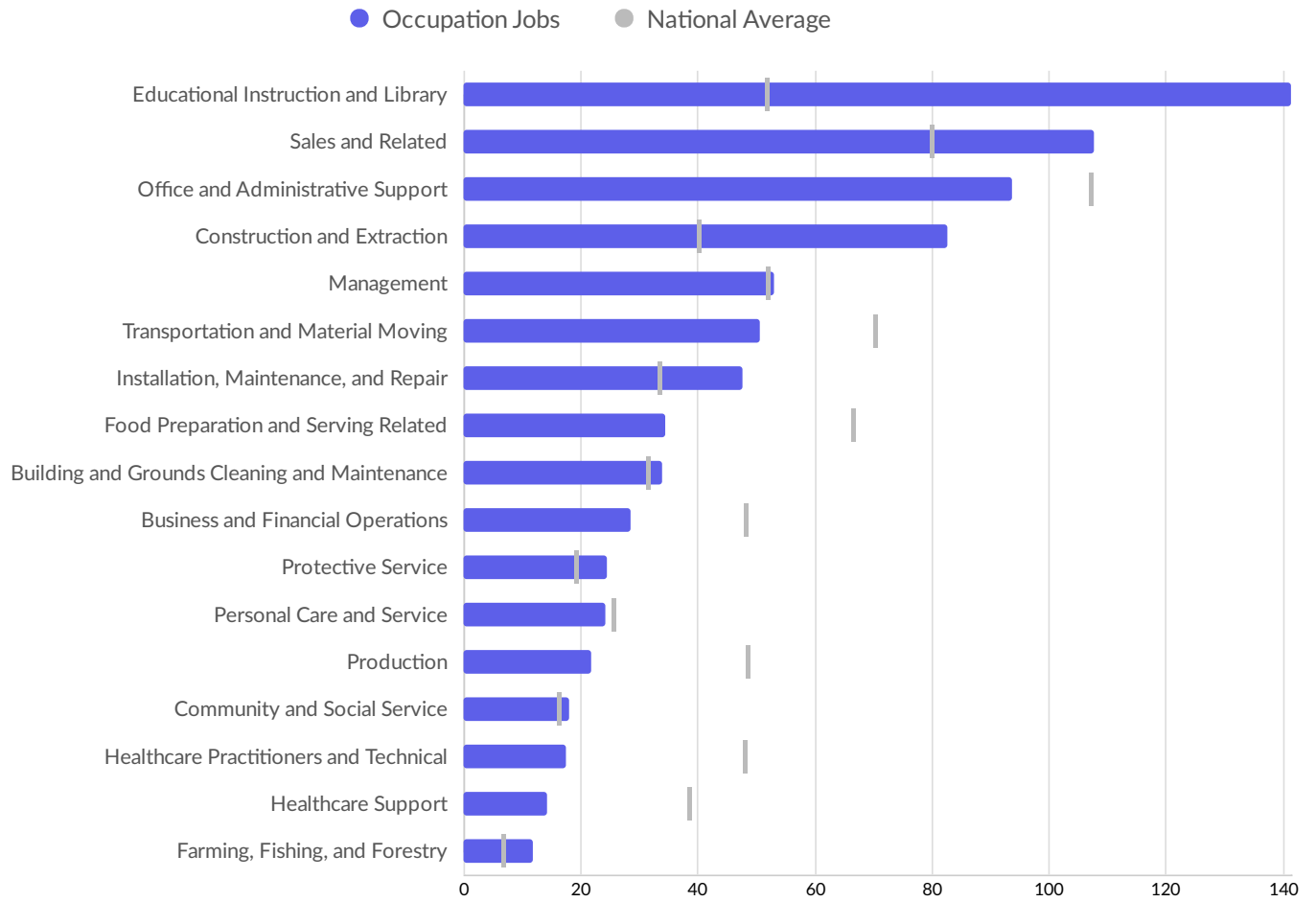
